Admission Notification & Guidelines for Admission to MBA-PS Course (2020-2022 Batch) for the Fourth List of Selected Candidates:

We are pleased to place the list of candidates who have performed satisfactorily in the Personal Interview round of admission process **conducted on 5th September, 2020** for admission to 2-year full time Master in Business Administration-Public Systems (MBA-PS) Course, **Session: 2020 - 2022** of the University of Calcutta that they may take admission to the Public Systems Management Department by making on-line payment of admission fees as per the instructions given in the admission brochure. **The date of commencement of MBA-PS course** will be announced later. Please note the following guidelines regarding admission:

1. You may pay the course fees by effecting a fund transfer through RTGS/NEFT in favour of IISWBM (Bank account details: Account Number 10252384198, State Bank of India, Surya Sen Street Branch, Kolkata, IFSC: SBIN0003496) **by 15th of September, 2020**. Please take the screen-shot of the payment reference or download the receipt and mail that promptly to mbapsadmission@iiswbm.edu Cc fo@iiswbm.edu.

Fees for the First Year: Rs1,86,500/-,
Payment for Students' Activity fund: Rs.10,000/-,
Refundable Library Caution Deposit: Rs.5000/-,
Refundable Security Deposit: Rs.5000/-

Total = Rs.2,06,500/- (payable during admission)

Fees for the Second Year: Rs.1,78,500/-

2. Payment of fees only ensures a provisional admission for you. Final Admission will take place only on compliance of the following:

- a) Physical verification of all documents relating to your academic credentials and payment of fees – **this will be done before the commencement of classes.**
- b) Approval of your qualifying degree/examination (that makes you eligible to apply for this course) by the University of Calcutta & issue of 'Equivalence Certificate' by the Calcutta University.
- c) Passing with at least 50% marks in the aggregate for the qualifying examination

Failure on any of the above counts will result in cancellation of admission and the fees deposited will be refunded after deducting amounts as per AICTE norms.

3. The admission of the candidates, who have appeared in their final examinations and the results have not yet been published, will be provisional subject to the production of evidence of passing the Honors Degree/Engineering Degree / Medical Science or its Equivalent Degree with at least 50% marks.
4. Final admission will be based on the qualification being approved by the University of Calcutta for admission to the MBA-PS Course in Department of Public Systems.
5. Candidates will have to submit valid MAT/CAT/GMAT/CMAT/JEMAT/GATE/XAT /ATMA score sheet, before their admission.

6. Outstation candidates seeking hostel facilities should request in writing for the same to the O.S.D. of the Institute at the time of admission. Seats will be offered on a first come first served basis as per availability of the seats.

7. **SC/ST/OBC** candidates who have not submitted their caste certificates along with the Admission Form must do so during the time of admission; otherwise their candidature will stand cancelled if they fail to be short-listed when considered in **General Category**.

8. If you have passed your last examination (graduate or postgraduate) from an university other than the University of Calcutta, you must obtain a Migration Certificate and submit the same to the University of Calcutta within one month from the date of commencement of the course.

9. It is suggested that students arrange their own Laptop as advanced learning accessories.
