The following students as detailed below have been selected for admission to Masters in Social Welfare (Two-year MSW ) programme of the Institute for the Session : 2017-2019. The Session will commence on Wednesday, July 19 at 10.30. am.

**The fees for the course are as follows:**

1. Fees for the 1<sup>st</sup> year : Rs. 90,000/- (including admission, tuition, development fees, refundable Library Caution deposit)
2. Fees for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year : Rs. 80,000/-
3. The total fees is also payable in four instalments of Rs 50,000/-, Rs40,000/- , Rs40,000/- , Rs40,000/-. The sum may be paid by any of the following options and must reach the Institute by 18<sup>th</sup> July 2017.
  - A/C payee bank draft / pay order/ banker's cheque etc. in favour of 'IISWBM'.
  - Cash deposit through fees challan.
  - RTGS/NEFT transfer to IISWBM, State Bank of India, Surya Sen Street Branch, Kolkata; A/C No. 10252384198; IFSC: SBIN0003496.
4. **Last Date of submission of fees: 18<sup>th</sup> July 2017** , between 11.00 hrs and 15.00 hrs. for students **whose names have appeared in the second list.**
5. **If a candidate fails to take admission** within the stipulated date, his/her admission offer will lapse automatically.

6. Students who have appeared in their final examinations but whose results have not yet been published, their admission will be provisional subject to the production of evidence of passing the Honours Degree Examination by 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2017.
7. Students who have passed their degree examination from a University other than Calcutta University must get a Migration Certificate and submit the same to Calcutta University within one month from the data of commencement of classes.
8. Outstation candidates seeking hostel facilities should request in writing for the same to the Administrative Office of the Institute at the time of admission. Available seats will be offered on a first come first served basis.
9. Candidates who have been asked to produce their Equivalence Certificates from the Calcutta University will have to produce the same before their admission is considered final.
10. Final admission will be based on the qualification being approved by the University of Calcutta for admission to the Master Degree course in Social Welfare.
